The International Cooperative Alliance – Asia Pacific (ICA - AP) in collaboration with the Central Union of Agricultural Cooperative of Japan (JA Zenchu), Institute for the Development of Agricultural Cooperation in Asia (IDACA) Japan will be organising the 3rd Training Course on "**Fostering Leaders to Reinforce Business Development of Agricultural Cooperatives in FY-2016**", from 17 July – 06 August 2016. The programme is funded by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) and implemented by ICA.



It may be pertinent to mention that the selected participant will be requested to continue to serve for the organization they belong to for five years and more after participating in the training course. The ICA grants fully paid scholarships to the participants, which include tuition fees, travels (international and domestic within Japan), board and lodging, textbooks etc. Economy class excursion tickets are generally issued, where feasible.

In case your organisations wish to nominate suitable candidate, you are requested to send the duly filled nomination form along with digital passport size photograph pasted in the form and scanned copy of the main page of the passport by e-mail only to reach us positively on or before 7th June 2016. *No nomination will be accepted after the due date i.e. 7th June 2016.* You will be also required to send one-page personal particulars of the nominee as per the attached format by e-mail along with the duly filled nomination form.

We may inform that as per prevailing practice NCUI collects Rs.1,500/- towards contribution to NCUI Corpus Fund and administrative expenses from the sponsoring organisation of the participants going abroad for attending Conferences / Seminars / Workshops / Training Courses etc. Hence, the sponsoring organisation will be required to pay Rs. 1,500/- before the departure of your nominee, if finally selected. **Only the candidate finally selected will be intimated.**
