Training Programme Report

The National Centre for Cooperative Education organized the following programmes during March, 2012 at New Delhi:

1. Programme on Business Management for the Leaders and Secretaries of Service Cooperative Banks of Kerala in collaboration with ICM, Kannur from 5 - 7 March, 2012.
2. Leadership Development Programme for Chairpersons/Women Directors of Cooperative Societies of India from 13-15 March, 2012.

Both the programmes were inaugurated by Dr. K.N. Sinha, Director, NCCE. The objectives of the programmes were elaborated by the respective programme coordinators viz. Dr.V.K. Dubey and Mr. Rajeev Sharma.

The programme schedule and reading material were prepared keeping in mind the broad objectives of the programmes.

Apart from general topics, sector-specific issues for the service cooperative banks and participation of women in cooperatives were discussed at length by subject experts from within the NCCE, ICM, Kannur and guest speakers. Stress was given on the legal aspects of cooperatives and the constitutional amendments that have been recently passed by the Parliament in the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002. The participants also actively participated in all discussions by discussing the latest developments, their problems and also suggested suitable remedies.

In addition participants of both the programmes were taken for local study visits to NCDC, TRIBES etc. The participants of the first programme were also taken to Mathura and Agra as part of their training programme.

The participants appreciated the efforts of NCCE in organizing these training programmes. The participants opined that such programmes not only give them a chance to interact with their contemporaries at the national-level but also help to refresh their knowledge and equip them with necessary tools to effectively face competition of the private sector.
