

**NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON REVAMPING COOPERATIVE EDUCATION AND TRAINING
TO BRING PROFESSIONALISM IN COOPERATIVES HELD ON 25.06.2018 AT NCUI
AUDITORIUM, NEW DELHI**

One of the objectives of NCUI is to strengthen its member institutions particularly the State Cooperative Unions whose main role is to provide Cooperative Education to the members of the various cooperative societies in that state and to play effective role in strengthening the Cooperative Education and Training Programmes implemented by the State Cooperative Unions.

To discharge their functions effectively, NCUI continued to organize National Level Conference of the Chairmen / Managing Directors / CEO's of the concerned State Cooperative Unions periodically to address the following main objectives:

1. To discuss the problems being faced by the State Cooperative Unions in running their Cooperative Education Programmes.
2. To acquaint the state officials about the latest schemes / policies and programmes of Central Government being implemented through NCUI, NCD, NABARD and other concerned departments for the promotion & development of Cooperative Education and training in India.
3. To keep skill development programme and trainers of training programme.
4. To chalk out suitable strategies for effective implementation, evaluation and monitoring of the cooperative education and training programmes.

In the light of the above, NCUI / NCCE has convened a National Level Conference on 25 June 2018 to address the issues related to above. Inviting all the Chairmen / Managing Directors / CEO's of the concerned states. The conference was attended by representatives from Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Goa, Gujarat, Jammu & Kashmir, Karnataka, Manipur, Maharashtra, Punjab, Odisha, Sikkim and Uttar Pradesh.

Dr. Chandra Pal Singh Yadav, Member of Parliament / President NCUI in his welcome address encouraged the participation of the Chairmen / Managing Directors / CEO's for strengthening the cooperative education and training institutions. He emphasised that to strengthen the Cooperative Education and trainings, it is the need of the hour to focus on the problems of the Unions and the Co-operators within their respective states. He also addressed the inability of Government funding for assisting the Cooperative Education Training Programme. For this he urged that all the states need to work together to sustain the Cooperative Education and Training. Besides, dignitaries / VIP's from various states were also present at the time.

Shri N. Satya Narayana, Chief Executive in his remarks said that the Central Sector Scheme on Cooperative Education and Training for assisting Junior Cooperative Training Centres in the Country needs to be strengthened for effective implementation of Cooperative Education Training in that states. Further, he also threw light upon how the Cooperative Education Fund can be utilized in effective manner for revamping the Cooperative Education Training Programme.

The conference strongly urged to provide effective education and training in all the states, to improve the quality of the services of Cooperative Education Fund and increase the assistance from Government. NCUI and State Cooperative Unions should work together to upgrade the institutions by improving the latest technology and provide need based support of their efforts to overcome the problems in Cooperative education and training. The participants interacted effectively in all the deliberations.

The recommendations as suggested by members will be sent to all the State Cooperative Unions for their effective implementation and development.
