

## **NCCE CONDUCTS LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR CHAIRMAN / DIRECTORS OF MULTI-STATE COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES 2-4 July 2018**

The Leadership Development Training Programme for Chairman / Directors of Multi-State Cooperative Societies consisting of 40 participants from the states of Assam, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Nagaland, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal attended the programme. The prime objective of the programme was to manage the Cooperative Society professionally for making it more viable and effective functioning and to provide the participants a platform to interact with their counterparts from all over the states and thus facilitate learning.

The programme was inaugurated by Sh. N. Satya Narayana, Chief Executive, NCUI in his special note on the occasion emphasized the need of the society, stressing that members concern & involvement in the working of cooperative society is more important and thus role & responsibility of cooperative leaders will be enhanced to greater extent. He also pointed out that Cooperative shares needs to be increased rather than Government shares and Multi-State Cooperative Societies 2002 provisions should be effectively implemented for functioning of the Cooperative Societies. He assured that this kind of training programmes will strengthen so that members will participate more & more effectively.

Further, in his special address he mentioned about the applicability of Section 80 P of the Income Tax Act and its implications towards Cooperative Societies which fall within the purview of Section 80 P of the Act are entitled to deduction in respect of any income referred to in Sub-Section (2) thereof.

As a part of the training programme, participants underwent a study visit to NCDC, New Delhi. Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Executive Director, NCDC made his presentation about the growth, development and policy issues of NCDC. Thereafter, he also gave a brief presentation about the Financial Assistance by NCDC to the Cooperative Societies especially for PACS, Weaker Sections of the Society, etc.

During the period, the participants interacted with the faculty members / resource persons for clearance of their doubts and discussions on the subject matter.

The participants also got inputs from the programmes about latest technologies, GST, Financial Assistance, the responsibilities of the management of cooperative societies & challenges come across for working of the societies. The programme was concluded on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018. The officials from Government of India, Managing Directors from different National level Organizations and Faculty of NCCE were also present. Dr. A. R. Srinath Deputy Director & Course Coordinator proposed a vote of thanks on the occasion.
