We are glad to inform that CICTAB is organising a Programme as above under the sponsorship of Reserve Bank of India, Mumbai and in collaboration with and at College of Agricultural Banking (CAB), Pune for the period from 24th- 28th September, 2018.

As per the decision taken by the Managing Committee in its recent meeting, to provide encouragement for conducting trainers training programmes by the member institutions in SAARC countries such as Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Bhutan and Maldives, CICTAB will bear the travel cost of one interpreter subject to ceiling of INR 25,000/- provided there are a minimum of 10 participants from a country for the Trainers' Training Programme. This facility will be available only for this trainers training programme.

- ii) The number of nominations may be limited to maximum 2 or 3.
